

Emergency Operations Quick Reference HAH EMERGENCY SERVICES CORE MISSIONS

HAH Emergency Services provides emergency preparedness and operations management services to over 115 health care coalition members throughout the State of Hawaii including hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, home care and hospice, air and ground ambulance, blood banks and clinical laboratories.



1. COORDINATE HEALTH CARE RESPONSE OPERATIONS

- HAH Emergency Operations Center (HAHEOC) in Honolulu coordinates the overall response of coalition members with county, state and federal agencies
- HAH Area Coordinators positioned within each county civil defense emergency operating center, coordinate county-level operations



2. DEPLOY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS

- Hawaii Disaster Medical Assistance Team (Hawaii DMAT) ^{see note below} provides on-scene, high-acuity casualty care services within 2 to 4 hours of request¹
- Hospital Emergency Response Team (HERT) personnel augment clinical operations in one or more hospital facilities to support medical surge
- Incident Management Teams (IMT) assist individual hospitals with complex operations – subject matter experts, communications, just-in-time training



3. MOBILIZE HEALTH CARE DELIVERY SYSTEMS

- Pre-positioned, air-transportable 20- and 50-bed Acute Care Modules (ACM) augment hospital services or support on-scene medical care – total of 150 beds
- Disaster Aero-medical Staging Facilities (DASF) support casualty evacuations at airport facilities by civilian and military aircraft



4. PROVIDE SPECIALTY LOGISTICAL SUPPORT

- Coordinated by HAH Operations Support Center (HAHOSC) in Honolulu
- HAH Area Caches (HAC), Human Remains Holding (HRH) containers, and single resources such as ventilators, pharmaceuticals, personal protective equipment, generators, emergency meals, voice and data communications, medical oxygen, HEPA scrubbers, chemical & radiological instruments and related equipment and supplies



5. SUPPORT PLANNING AND PREPAREDNESS

- Training and exercise program
- Technical assistance, workshops and planning workgroups



¹ Hawaii DMAT is also known as *Kalawao Rescue* within the State of Hawaii; a nonfederal configuration of the team that provides enhanced services to the State of Hawaii. *Kalawao Rescue* is administered by HAH Emergency Services.
